We wanted to be successful. We have accumulated over three hundred tapes which cost about \$5.00 each and owned many books which were also expensive. We bought a lot of supplies from AMWAY for our AMWAY business. We invested our time and money and put ourselves in debt because of it. We never got any monetary gain as promised. We were told lies. We did everything we were told, we showed the plan, bought and listened to the tapes, read the books, and attended seminars. We were so religious about the system that we made it to the EAGLE level.
