To Whom It May Concern:

We were Amway distributors for the last 11 years, during which time we were involved with the Yeager System. We were told it is impossible to build the business without being completely "loyal" to the four components of the system, which are a minimum of two tapes every week, a book every month, going to every seminar you "qualify" for (which can easily be three events a month), and showing the business to other people. We have done this for the past eleven years. We both got involved in the system when we were seventeen. It has taken us this long to realize what a waste of time and money the system is. We have never made a profit with the business. Every year, we have shown a loss for thousands of dollars. We have supported the system from our jobs, which has been quite difficult. I have included a rough estimate of what we have spent directly on the tools and functions. This does not include such things as gas, mileage, wear and tear on vehicles, food, babysitters, etc. ...
